Introduction

Omnia autem honeste et secundum ordinem fiant. 1 Cor. 14, 40.

This liturgical calendar, together with these introductory notes, has been compiled in accordance with the Motu Proprio *Rubricarum Instructum* issued by Pope St John XXIII on 25th July 1960, the Roman Breviary of 1961, the Roman Missal of 1962, and the decrees *Cum Sanctissima* and *Quo Magis* issued by the Congregation of the Doctrine of the Faith on the 25th March 2020.

For the universal calendar that to be found at the beginning of the Roman Breviary and Missal has been used. For the diocesan calendars no such straightforward procedure is possible. The decree of the Sacred Congregation of Rites of 26th July 1960 at paragraph (6) required all diocesan calendars to conform to the new rubrics and be approved by that Congregation.

The diocesan calendars in use on 1st January 1961 (the date set for the new rubrics to come into force) were substantially those previously in use but with varying adjustments and presumably as yet to be re-approved. Indeed those calendars in use immediately prior to that date were by no means identical to those previously approved by the Congregation, since there had been various changes to the rubrics made by Pope Pius XII. Hence it is not a simple matter to ascertain in complete and exact detail the classifications and dates of all diocesan feasts as they were, or should have been, observed at 1st January 1961. The solution adopted has been to use the latest available Roman Missal that includes as a supplement all the diocesan calendars for England and Wales (Imprimatur 1949). The dates and classifications of the feasts from this supplement have been compared with three further sources: firstly the diocesan year books, secondly a variety of layman's missals and thirdly previous editions of this liturgical calendar.

The year books have been considered the most reliable of the additional sources, as evidencing the actual practice of the dioceses concerned. Unfortunately, however, only those for Westminster, Southwark, Brentwood and Birmingham have been available to date. As far as layman's missals are concerned there is unfortunately some lack of unanimity between those consulted. However, in any case, no change has been made to the dates and classifications of feasts found in previous editions of this calendar except where new information has been forthcoming or where another date or classification seems more probable.

Four dioceses have been created since 1962 and for these there exist no appropriate calendars. To provide calendars for the dioceses of Arundel and Brighton, East Anglia and Wrexham, the calendars of Southwark, Northampton and Menevia (from whose territory respectively the new dioceses were created) have been adopted with changes where appropriate. To provide a calendar

for the diocese of Hallam, which was created from territory taken both from Leeds and Nottingham, only those Feasts which are common to both have been adopted, again with changes where appropriate. The titles of these four dioceses are given within brackets.

This Ordo's entries for the complicated unchanging liturgical days, such as Good Friday, remain entirely the work of Mr Gordon Dimon, the previous composer of this annual Ordo. The Ordo's format, and this introduction, remain almost entirely his, as does the supplementary material in this booklet, apart from the note on the decrees *Quo Magis* and *Cum Sanctissima*; the two sections respectively entitled 'A Very Short Rubrical Primer for Parish Pastors' and 'When may I say...?', which I myself first wrote for last year's Ordo; and the section 'Abbreviations', which I thoroughly revised for the same.

I would like to thank Joseph Shaw, Kevin Jones, Richard Pickett and all the staff in the LMS office for providing me with much valuable assistance in the preparation of this Ordo. Together we have tried to make this liturgical calendar as accurate and useful as possible, but any remaining errors are mine alone. Suggestions or comments on the contents of the Ordo are as ever most welcome.

The initial draft of this Ordo was produced with my Ordo-generating software, which takes any one set of local propers as its input, and then generates an Ordo in the LMS format. The computer-generated draft was then tweaked by hand.

All Saints' Day, 2023

A note on the CDF decrees *Cum sanctissima* and *Quo magis*, issued 25th March 2020

Optional Masses and offices

The decree *Cum Sanctissima* introduces a new sub-category of 3rd-Class feasts, which are listed in this Ordo as ‘III cl (Priv.)’—i.e. ‘privileged third-class feasts’. The decree creates new rules which I summarize under the following three headings:

The celebration of third class feasts in Lent

- 1 The Mass and office of privileged third-class feasts may (optionally) be celebrated on ferias of the third class within Lent and Passiontide, provided that a privileged commemoration of the feria is kept. (That is, the feria should be commemorated at all Masses, and at lauds and vespers).

The celebration of votive Masses and offices of the day's saints on 3rd-class (and 4th-class) days.

- 2 On third-class vigils, on non-privileged third-class feasts, and on fourth-class days, the Mass of any saint inscribed in the Martyrology for that day—even one inscribed after 1962—may be celebrated as a votive ‘festive Mass’ (Rubrics 302f). (That is, the Mass may be celebrated as if it were of a 3rd-class feast, with Gloria but no Creed).
- 3 If such a festive Mass is celebrated, the Divine Office may also be of the saint, in which case it should be observed as an ‘Ordinary’ office.
- 4 If such a festive Mass (and optionally, office) is said on a 3rd-class day of the calendar, there should be an ‘ordinary’ commemoration of the omitted celebration. This means that the omitted saint(s), blessed(s), or vigil should be commemorated at low Mass (and at lauds). Whether the day of the calendar is of the 3rd or 4th class, its own commemorations should also be kept in such any Festival Mass, provided that the total number of commemorations not exceed two.
- 5 Rules 2 and 3 do not apply where the celebration of a festive Mass would prevent the fulfilment of an obligation of a conventual Mass, or when the Mass of the Rogations is to be said on the days of the litanies. (See Rubrics 304b).

The celebration of votive Masses and commemorations of new saints generally

- 6 On all days of the 3rd or 4th class, an ordinary commemoration of any saint or mystery may be made *ad libitum* at Mass on the day on which it is inscribed in a proper of saints ‘for certain places’, or in a new supplement, provided that it does not take the total number of commemorations celebrated above two.
- 7 Additionally, Masses of saints inscribed in the Martyrology after 1962 may be celebrated as votive Masses (in accordance with the pre-existing rubrics on votive Masses).
- 8 It falls to the heads of religious houses to decide how to apply these provisions to the celebration of conventual Mass, and to the choral or communal celebration of the Divine Office.

These rules create two oddities. First: a votive ‘festive Mass’ of a saint (or group of saints) in the day’s martyrology may now be said on any non-privileged 3rd-class feast day within Advent, whereas such a Mass cannot be said on a 3rd-class feria of Advent—even though 3rd-class ferias of Advent rank lower than 3rd-class feasts. Second: local 3rd-class feasts continue to outrank universal 3rd-class feasts, even privileged ones. Hence when a local 3rd-class feast falls on the same day as, and outranks, a privileged (universal) 3rd-class feast, rules 2-7 apply locally.

Note furthermore that, even according to the original 1962 rubrics, the Mass of a third-class feast that is displaced by a higher-ranking third-class feast, may optionally be said instead of the Mass of the higher-ranking feast. (See *Rubrics* 302f).

Optional prefaces


The decree *Quo magis* introduces seven new optional prefaces:

- **The Preface of Martyrs** may be said on the feast of any martyr who does not have a proper preface.
- **The Preface of the Dedication of a Church** may be said at any Mass of the dedication of a church (whether a Mass of actual dedication or Mass of the anniversary of a dedication), except the Mass of the dedication of St Mary of the Snows and the Mass of dedication of St Michael the Archangel.
- **The Preface of All Saints and of Patron Saints** may be said on festive and votive Masses of All Saints, and on festive and votive Masses of primary and secondary patrons, and also on Masses of the titular saint of the church or oratory; but never on Masses of angels, or on Masses of saints that have a proper preface.

- **The Preface of the Most Holy Sacrament** may be said at the Masses of the feast of Corpus Christi, at votive Masses of the most holy sacrament, and at votive Masses of Our Lord Jesus Christ Eternal High Priest.
- **The Nuptial Preface** may be said on Masses ‘For Bride and Bridegroom’ (‘Pro Sponsis’)
- **The Preface of the Angels** may be said on Masses of angels and on the feast of the dedication of St Michael the Archangel on the 29th September.
- **The Preface of Saint John the Baptist** may be said on festive and votive Masses of St John the Baptist.

The official rubrics for these new prefaces seem to imply that it is possible for the ‘Preface of Martyrs’ and the ‘Preface of All Saints and Patron Saints’ *both* to be options on certain days. I have assumed that this is indeed the case.

#	<p>The code ‘#’ is only found on non-privileged third class feasts and the third class vigil. We can call the feast or vigil the <i>calendar celebration</i>.</p> <p>The code indicates that today one may celebrate a votive Mass of any saint listed in the latest edition of the Martyrology for today, even a saint added after 1962. The votive Mass is to be kept as a ‘festive Mass’ (rubrics 301ff): i.e. with Gloria and No Creed, as for a third-class feast. At low Mass, the calendar celebration should be commemorated, and if there is also a commemoration in the calendar, it should be kept too. If there are two commemorations in the calendar, only one should be kept.</p> <p>Where a votive festive Mass of a saint is celebrated, the day’s office may also be of the same saint. It is to be an ‘Ordinary office’: i.e. as for a 3rd-class feast, with one nocturn and the Te Deum at Mattins. For the third reading of the nocturn, one should use the fourth reading from the appropriate common. At lauds, the calendar celebration should be commemorated, as if there is also a commemoration in the calendar, it should be kept too. If there are two commemorations in the calendar, only one should be kept.</p> <p>There is no limit to the number of votive festive Masses said today, nor need they all be the same.</p>
†	<p>Any votive Mass may be celebrated today as a 4th-class Mass. This Mass may be any of the votive Masses given in the missal or an approved appendix; or the Mass of any saint in the latest edition of the Martyrology or an approved supplement thereto.</p> <p>The creed is not said in 4th-class votive Masses. The Gloria is said only on: —Masses ‘of the Angels’ (Missae de Angelis); —Masses of Our Lady celebrated on a Saturday.</p> <p>Commemorations in the day’s calendar are kept at low Mass.</p> <p>There is no limit to the number of 4th-class votive Masses said today, nor need they all be the same.</p>
‡	<p>As for ‘†’ above, but in addition any number of 4th-class Masses for the dead (the ‘daily’ Masses for the dead) may be celebrated. Commemorations in the day’s calendar are not kept in Masses for the dead.</p>

IH	<p>One third-class Votive Mass of the Immaculate Heart of Mary may be celebrated today.</p> <p>Gl No Cr Pr of the BVM <i>Et te in Veneratione</i> Commemoration of any displaced third-class day at low Mass. Other commemorations in the day's calendar are also said at low Mass, but the total number of commemorations must not exceed two.</p>
JCHP	<p>One third-class Votive Mass of Jesus Christ the Eternal High Priest may be celebrated today.</p> <p>Gl No Cr Pr of the Most Holy Sacrament or Common Pr Commemoration of any displaced third-class day at low Mass. Other commemorations in the day's calendar are also said at low Mass, but the total number of commemorations must not exceed two.</p>
JCHP*	<p>One third-class Votive Mass of Jesus Christ the Eternal High Priest may be celebrated today, unless one has already been celebrated in the same church this month. Details as above.</p>
SH	<p><u>Two</u> third-class Votive Masses of the Sacred Heart of Jesus may be celebrated today.</p> <p>Gl No Cr Pr of the Sacred Heart Commemoration of any displaced third-class day at low Mass. Other commemorations in the day's calendar are also said at low Mass, but the total number of commemorations must not exceed two.</p>

Funerals

Funeral Masses are celebrated in the presence of the body, or, for a good reason, even in its absence. Funeral Masses are prohibited on:

Funeral Masses are also prohibited:

- On first-class feasts that are holydays of obligation in the church where the Mass is to be celebrated.
- On the anniversary of the dedication of the church.
- On the titular feast of the church.
- On the feast of a principal patron of a town or city.
- On the titular feast or the feast of the holy founder of the order or congregation to which the church belongs.
- During an exposition of the blessed sacrament.
- In churches having only one Mass:
 - if the Mass of the Rogations is to be said.
 - on February 2nd, if there is to be a blessing of candles
 - on Ash Wednesday, if there is to be a blessing of ashes.

Funeral Masses are permitted on all other days. The Mass is:

- For non-priests, the Mass ‘On the Day of Death or Burial’ (‘In Die Obitus seu Depositionis Defuncti’).
- For priests, the first Mass given for All Souls’ day, with the proper collects assigned in the missal among the ‘various prayers’ for the departed.

The sequence *Dies irae* must be said at funeral Masses, as must the absolution over the corpse. (If the corpse is not present, the absolution must be said over a catafalque).

Other Masses connected with deaths

On:

- the day of a death
- the day on which the news of a death is received
- the final burial in the church of a body that had already been buried elsewhere

a Mass of the dead may be said in accordance with the rules above, on any day of the 2nd class or lower except Sunday. The sequence *Dies irae* and the absolution over the corpse or catafalque are optional.

In the same way, on:

- the 3rd, 7th, and 30th days after a death or burial
- the anniversary of a death or burial, or the established annual recurrence of a foundation Mass, or the established annual commemoration of the deceased of some group

a Mass of the Dead may be said on any day of the 3rd class or lower, using the appropriate prayers. The Mass is, for priests, as above; for non-priests, also as above except that the Mass ‘In Anniversario Defunctorum’ is used for anniversaries. The sequence and the absolution are optional.

Weddings and wedding anniversaries

Weddings are usually celebrated with the following rites in the following order:

1. The solemnization of the marriage.
2. A wedding Mass, including the solemn nuptial blessing (always imparted by the celebrant of the Mass).

Different clerics may preside over parts one and two.

Weddings are permitted at all times except on All Souls’ Day and during the Sacred Triduum, but weddings during Lent or Advent require the ordinary’s permission and should be celebrated with comparative sobriety. Whenever a wedding is permitted:

- On days of the 2nd class or lower other than Sundays, the wedding Mass is the votive Mass “For Bride and Bridegroom”.
- On Sundays and on days of the 1st class, the wedding Mass is the Mass of the day, but the collect of the Mass “For Bride and Bridegroom” is added to the day’s collect under the same conclusion. The nuptial blessing is given in the usual way.

Golden and Silver Wedding Anniversaries

A Mass to commemorate a 25th or 50th anniversary of a wedding may be said on any day of the 2nd class or lower. It should be the Mass of the Most Holy Trinity or any Mass of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The votive collect 'for thanksgiving' ('Pro gratiarum actione') is added to the Mass's collect under the same conclusion. After the Mass, the prayers found in the Roman ritual tit. 8, ch. 7, are said over the couple.

4th-class votive Masses may of course be said in thanksgiving for other anniversaries, in accordance with the usual rules.

List of Votive Masses

Excluding special ritual Masses, and certain Masses for special occasions and places, the following Masses may be said as votive Masses.

The collects of these Masses, and the various collects for the Mass 'For any need', may be added, in last place, to the collects of any 3rd-class or 4th-class day, at the discretion of the celebrant, provided that the total number of collects (including the collect of the day) not exceed three. So may any suitable collect from the Masses for the dead.

The Colours of Vestments for Votive Masses

See General Rubrics of the Roman Missal 117ff

The colour **white** is used for Votive Masses:

- Of the Lord, except for those of the mysteries and instruments of his Passion
- Of the Blessed Virgin Mary
- Of the Holy Angels
- Of non-martyred saints; of St John Apostle and Evangelist
- For the coronation of the pope, and the anniversaries of the pope and the diocesan bishop

The colour **red** is used for Votive Masses:

- Of the Lord's passion
- Of the Holy Spirit
- Of holy apostles and evangelists except St John
- Of martyrs
- Of holy relics
- For the election of the pope

The colour **violet** is used for the Votive Masses indicated above.

However, for non-conventional low votive Masses of the 4th class, it is permissible to use the colour of the office of the day if that is green or white. (Rubrics of the Romal Missal 323).

The Missal

Notes on changes in the organization of material in LMS Ordo since the 2021-2022 edition

For the Masses on the external solemnities of the Sacred Heart and the B.V.M. of the Rosary, and the votive Masses of the Rogations, see Ordo. For the first Thursday, Friday and Saturday of the month, see ‘JCHP’, ‘SH’, and ‘IH’ in the section ‘Abbreviations’ (page vii). For details of Masses of the dead, see ‘Rubrical Primer’ (page x).

Terminology

Throughout this Ordo, by a High Mass is understood a Mass sung with the assistance of Deacon and Subdeacon and by a Sung Mass a Mass sung without the assistance of Deacon and Subdeacon.

Changes in the 1962 Missal

- At a High Mass the celebrant no longer reads the Epistle and Gospel (or any other lesson) but listens while these are sung; seated at the sedilia for the Epistle (or any other lesson), standing at the altar as previously for the Gospel.
- The Confiteor is no longer said immediately before the people’s Communion and hence the Celebrant does not say *Misereatur* and *Indulgentiam*.
- *Benedicamus Domino* does not now normally occur, being restricted to the evening Mass on Holy Thursday, Mass on Corpus Christi when followed by the procession and Mass on the opening and closing days of the Quarant’ore. On all other occasions, excepting Requiems, *Ite Missa est* is now said.
- At a Requiem Mass whenever the Absolutions follow the Last Gospel is omitted. The Creed is no longer said on Feasts of Doctors of the Church.

(*Ritus Servandus in Celebratione Missae*, VI 4, 5, 8. XII 4)

Sacred Music

- During High or Sung Mass nothing may be sung in the vernacular.
- If the Sanctus and Benedictus are sung in plainsong they are chanted without a break between them, otherwise the Benedictus is to be sung after the Consecration.
- During the Consecration all singing must cease, nor may the organ (or any other musical instrument) be played.

- The Communion antiphon is sung as the Celebrant distributes Holy Communion. If anything else is sung it is to follow the Communion antiphon.

(*De Sacra Musica* – Instruction of the Sacred Congregation of Rites on Sacred Music and Liturgy 3rd September 1958)

Votive Mass for an External Solemnity

The ‘External Solemnity’ of a feast is the celebration of it without the office, for the good of the faithful, on a Sunday, on or the day on which the feast is impeded.

External solemnities belong to the following feasts by right. In the below list, unless a Sunday is specified in brackets, the external solemnity may be celebrated on the Sunday before or after the proper feast day.

- The Feast of the Most Sacred Heart. (3rd Sunday after Pentecost; listed in Ordo)
- The Feast of the Blessed Virgin Mary of the Rosary. (1st Sunday of October; listed in Ordo)
- The feast of a duly constituted principal patron. (Possible external solemnities for the feast of St George, principal patron of England, are listed in this year’s Ordo. The feast of St David falls between two Sundays of Lent this year, and so no external solemnity of it is possible).
- The anniversary of the dedication of the church in which the Mass is said.
- The titular feast of the church.
- The titular feast of the order or congregation to which the church belongs.
- The feast of the holy founder of the order of congregation.
- Any feast of the 1st or 2nd class which the local ordinary (i.e. in most cases, one’s bishop) judges to be celebrated with an especially large attendance of the faithful.
- Any feast of the 1st or 2nd class that is connected with some special liturgical service that is transferred to a Sunday with the approval of the Holy See, only for the Mass connected with the special service.

Unless otherwise specified only two Masses are allowed for any one external solemnity, of which only one may be high or sung. Masses of External Solemnities are of the 2nd class: hence they may not be said on days of the first class.

(General Rubrics of Missal 356-361)

External solemnities on holydays of obligation in England and Wales

The Bishops of England and Wales have requested that any Holyday of Obligation in England and Wales that is transferred to a Sunday in the New Rite should likewise be celebrated on that

same day in the Old Rite. Following a dubium from the LMS the Pontifical Commission Ecclesia Dei in its reply (N107/97 20 October 2008) confirmed that such an external solemnity is to be regulated according to the General Rubrics of the 1962 Missal (356-361). It further confirmed that it is legitimate to continue to celebrate the Mass and Office of these holydays on the days prescribed in the 1962 Calendar.

In 2024, the following holydays are transferred:

- The Epiphany (Saturday 6th January → Sunday 7th January)
- Corpus Christi (Thursday 30th May → Sunday 2nd June)
- SS Peter and Paul (Saturday 29th June → Sunday 30th June)

The external solemnities for these days are listed in the Ordo.

Votive Mass of the Blessed Sacrament on the Days Following Corpus Christi

Where, during the seven days following the Feast of Corpus Christi, a procession of the Blessed Sacrament is held, Mass of the Blessed Sacrament may be celebrated as a Votive Mass of II Class. Gloria, no Sequence, no Creed, Common Preface. (On the Sunday with Gloria and Creed, Preface of the Holy Trinity, no commemoration of the Sunday, no Sequence).

Two such occasions are allowed. This Mass may not be celebrated on days of the I Class.

(Rub. of 1962 Missal given after Corpus Christi)

Third class feasts displaced by other third-class feasts

The Mass of any third-class feast that is displaced by a higher-ranking third-class feast may be said instead of the higher-ranking third-class feast, with a commemoration of the higher-ranking feast at low Mass.

Mass of a Commemorated Saint on a IV Class

Where on a IV Class the commemoration of a Saint is ordered, the Mass of the commemorated Saint may be said ad lib instead of the I Mass. Where two commemorations of Saints are ordered the Mass may be of either ad lib, but in this case a commemoration of the other Saint is made.

(Gen. Rub. Missal 302-303)

Commemorations

Commemorations are either privileged or ordinary.

Privileged commemorations are made in all Masses, and at Lauds and Vespers; ordinary commemorations are made only in Low Masses (and Conventual Masses) and at Lauds (but not Vespers).

The privileged commemorations are:

- of a Sunday,
- of a day of I Class,
- of a day within the Octave of Christmas,
- of the September Ember Days,
- of the s of Advent, Lent and Passiontide,
- of the Greater Litanies (in Mass, no commemoration made in the Office).

All other commemorations are ordinary.

There are in addition certain Collects (with Secrets and Postcommunions) which are ordered to be said under one conclusion with the Collect, Secret and Postcommunion of the Mass. These added prayers referred to in this Calendar as 'commemorations', though not strictly such, are made in all Masses and are reckoned as only one prayer with the prayers of the Mass. Examples of such added prayers are those for the Pope, the Bishop and the propagation of the Faith. No mention is made of them in the Office.

- On days of the 1st class and in High or Sung Masses (non-conventual) only one commemoration, which must be privileged, is admitted.
- On Sundays of the 2nd class, and all other 2nd-class days that fall on a Sunday, only one commemoration is admitted: a privileged commemoration; or, if no privileged commemoration, an ordinary commemoration of a 2nd-class feast.
- On other days of the 2nd class only one commemoration is admitted.
- On days of 3rd or 4th class two commemorations (and not more) are admitted.

Prayers for the Supreme Pontiff, the Bishop and the Priest Himself

On the day of the coronation of the supreme pontiff, on its anniversary and on either the election, consecration or translation of the diocesan bishop (once as chosen by the bishop) for the conventual Mass in the cathedral is said the proper votive Mass, as a votive Mass of the 2nd class. This Mass is permitted on all days of the 2nd, 3rd or 4th class. If the anniversary is perpetually impeded it is permanently moved to the nearest day not so impeded. If it is accidentally impeded by the Nativity of OLJC, Easter Sunday, Whit Sunday, or any day within the octave of these three feasts, a day in the Sacred Triduum, the Epiphany, the Ascension, the Most Holy Trinity, Corpus Christi, the Sacred Heart, OLJC the King or the Commemoration of all the Faithful Departed it

is transferred to the nearest day not of I Class. If it is otherwise accidentally impeded the votive Mass is only commemorated for that year. On that day, when the votive Mass is to be said or commemorated in the cathedral, in all churches, or all churches of the diocese for the bishop's anniversary, the collect, secret and postcommunion for the supreme pontiff or bishop is to be added to all Masses (except requiems) under one conclusion with the collect etc of the Mass.

N.B. In recent years the compilers of this Ordo have ceased to make any mention of the collects for bishops other than that for the pope himself, because it has proved difficult to get all members of the local episcopate to say when they would like to keep their anniversary day in the traditional rite.

On the anniversary of his ordination to the priesthood every priest may add the collect etc. for himself under one conclusion to the collect etc. of the Mass (except a requiem Mass), provided that it is not the Nativity of OLJC etc. as listed above. When so impeded the collect etc. is transferred to the nearest day not so impeded.

(Gen. Rub. of Missal 343(c), 362-364, 449-450)

Feasts Proper to a Diocese and a Church

Feasts proper to a diocese include:

- the feast of the principal patron of the diocese (1st class),
- the feast of the secondary patron of the diocese (2nd class),
- the anniversary of the day of the dedication of the cathedral (1st class).
- However the feast of the titular of the cathedral is no longer, simply by virtue of its being the titular, observed throughout the diocese as a 1st-class feast

Feasts proper to a church include:

- the anniversary of the day of the Dedication of the Church, if consecrated (1st class),
- the Feast of the Titular of the Church, if consecrated or at least solemnly blessed (1st class).

(Gen. Rub. 40-47)

Mass on 5th and 7th Days within the Octave of the Nativity of OLJC

Those using a pre-1962 edition of the Roman Missal should note:

In these editions no formula is given for the 5th and 7th days within the octave of Nativity, since these days were formerly observed as the feasts of St Thomas B M and of St Silvester P C respectively. However, in the 1962 universal calendar these feasts were reduced to that given for 6th

day within the octave but with appropriate commemorations. (In England and Wales however the 5th day is observed as the feast of St Thomas with the rank of 1st class, as noted).

The Breviary

The Ordering of the Divine Office

A reference to 'Psalter' means that the relevant text will be found in the psalter of a standard breviary under the correct day of the week. One may need to choose the right material for the season, as indicated by the headings within the psalter. Pentecost Sunday is as for a Festal day.

Notes on the tables of occurrence and concurrence

- Feasts of OLJC, dedication feasts, and Sundays, all belong to one class, and one may never be commemorated on another.
- A feast of OLJC of the first or second class, occurring on a Sunday, takes the place of the Sunday with all its rights and privileges (including first vespers). No commemoration is made of the Sunday.
- If two feasts of the same Divine Person or two feasts of the same saint or beatus occur on the same day, the office is that of the feast which holds the higher place in the Table of Precedence and the other is omitted.
- In occurrence, a Sunday of I Class is preferred to any feast, however whenever the Immaculate Conception falls on the Second Sunday of Advent the feast is to be celebrated and the Sunday commemorated.
- In the tables below, ‘**O**’ denotes impossible occurrence or concurrence respectively.

Prayers for Benediction

The following prayers should be said during Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament as noted:

At the principal Benediction on Sundays and Holydays of Obligation O Blessed Virgin Mary. However, on 2nd Sunday of the month this is replaced by Hail Mary together with O Merciful God and O Loving Lord Jesus.

On the Friday, Saturday and Sunday following the Feast of Corpus Christi in all Cathedrals, and as far as possible in Parish Churches, the Triduum in honour of the Blessed Sacrament.

On the Feast of the Sacred Heart, the Act of Reparation to the Sacred Heart. The form of Consecration to and the Litany of the Sacred Heart of Jesus may also be said.

On the Sunday after the Feast of SS Peter and Paul, or on the Feast itself should it fall on a Sunday, the Dedication of England to St Peter.

On 1st Sunday of October the Dedication of England to the BVM.

On the Feast of OLJC the King the Form of Consecration to and the Litany of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

From 1st October to 2nd November inclusive the October Devotions.

In Wales whenever Solemn Benediction is given O Almighty God together with the Invocations that follow.

Indulgences

Various Days on Which a Plenary Indulgence May be Gained

- On 1st January, if the hymn *Veni Creator* is publicly recited or sung.
- On any Friday in Lent or Passiontide, by reciting the prayer *En ego* in front of an image of OLJC Crucified after having received Holy Communion.
- On Holy Thursday, at the singing of *Tantum ergo* during the ceremonies.
- On Good Friday, by kissing the Cross during the ceremonies.
- On Holy Saturday, by joining in the Renewal of Baptismal Promises during the Vigil.
- On Whit Sunday, if the hymn *Veni Creator* is publicly recited or sung.
- On the Feast of Corpus Christi, at the singing of *Tantum ergo* after the procession.
- On the Feast of the Sacred Heart, if the Act of Reparation is publicly recited and the Litany of the Sacred Heart of Jesus is sung or recited before the exposed Blessed Sacrament.
- On the Feast of SS Peter and Paul, by using any pious object blessed by the Supreme Pontiff or a bishop and making a profession of faith using any approved formula.
- On the 2nd of August (Portiuncula), by visiting a church and there reciting a *Pater* and *Credo*.
- On the Feast of OLJC the King, if the Form of Consecration is publicly recited with the Litany of the Sacred Heart, before the exposed blessed sacrament.
- On All Souls' Day, only applicable to the Souls in Purgatory, by visiting a church or oratory and there reciting a *Pater* and *Credo*.
- Daily, between 1st to 8th of November inclusive, only applicable to the Souls in Purgatory, by visiting a cemetery and there praying for the Faithful Departed. On All Souls' Day itself, this means of gaining an indulgence is an alternative to the option given above.
- On 31st December, if the *Te Deum* is publicly recited or sung.
- On the feast of the title of any church, by visiting the church and there reciting a *Pater* and *Credo*.

Appendix

Birmingham:

S Chad, being the titular of the cathedral, would have been I Class in the diocese before the promulgation of the *Motu Proprio Rubricarum Instructum*. After this the titular of the cathedral ceased to be I Class in any church other than the cathedral itself and S Chad seems to have been reduced to II Class in the diocese, perhaps as a secondary patron. In 1964, though not 1962 or 1963, he was classed as a primary patron and hence would again become I Class. This is confirmed by relevant year books.

Since during the Christmas Octave, of diocesan feasts, only those of I Class and in honour of saints who are on those days inscribed in the universal calendar, even though only by a commemoration, are now to be admitted, the commemoration of S Egwin on 30th December is no longer made, the feast being transferred to 3rd January. (Gen. Rub. 68 f.) This is confirmed by relevant year books.

It seems most probable that in these dioceses, St Oswald would have been moved to 11th August in order to allow for the celebration of the Vigil of St Laurence, but no absolute confirmation is currently available. In Liverpool, St Oswald was always kept on 11th August.
